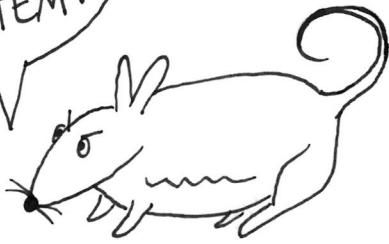

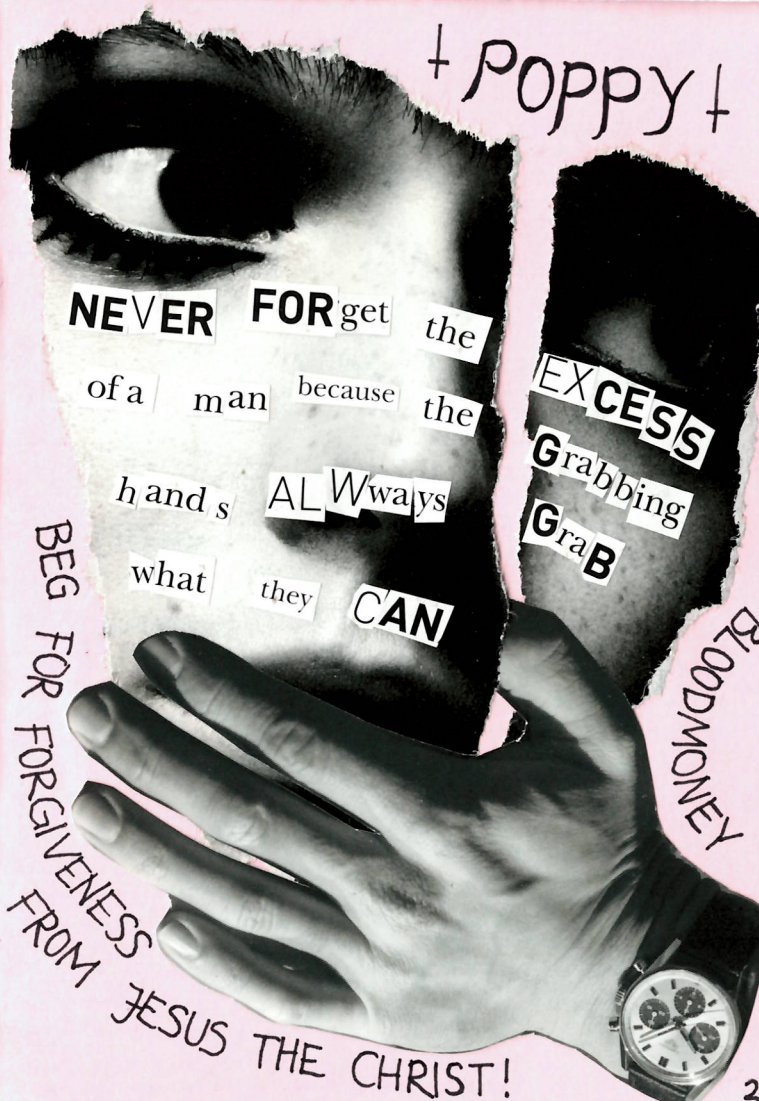

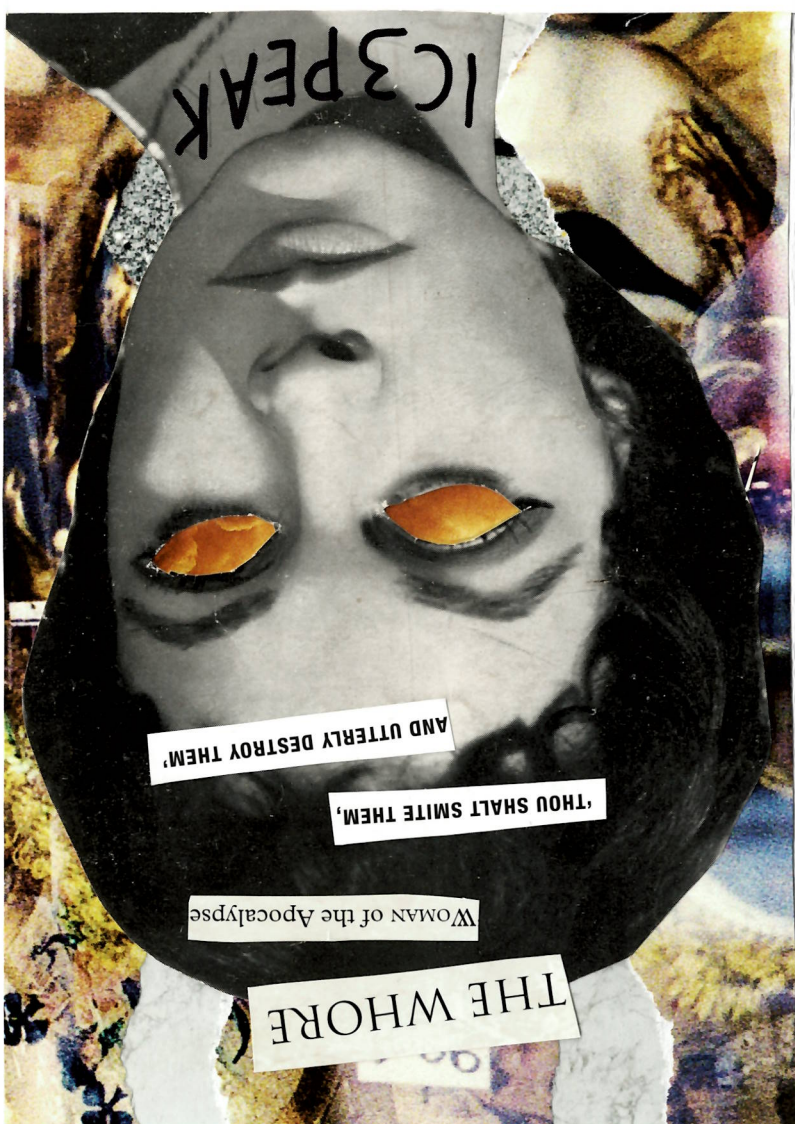

All subcultures have always been important spaces for radical political and emotional expression, but the music scene has historically been very male-dominated. This means that certain types of emotion, and certain types of politics such as intersectional feminism, have been absent or underrepresented in those spaces. Punk and metal subcultures are important spaces to express anger and disillusionment, but male-dominated interpretations of these emotions have often alienated women and other genders from these communities. This is changing rapidly thanks to the many incredible non-male and non-white musicians entering the scene. Feminine rage is an important type of anger that often comes from a place of life-long constraint and humiliation by a patriarchal, heterosexist society. It is an assertion of our claim to a world that has for so long denied us a real place in it.

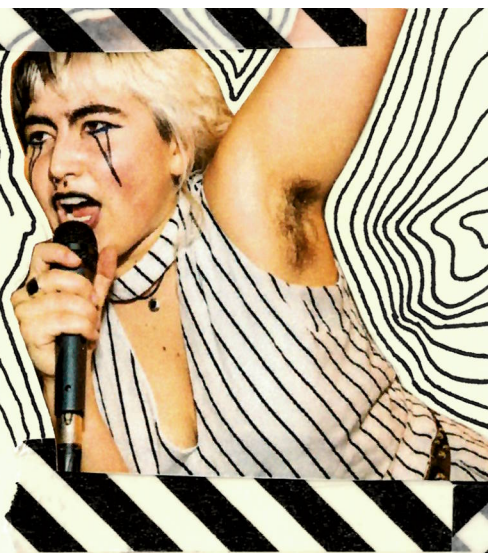
